

Salls Youth Ranch will be number three

CLEARWATER — Planning and engineering studies have begun for the D. A. Salls Youth Ranch which is expected to open for business in 1978 as the third child care institution sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association.

The site — a large private home with swimming pool and fishing pond located northeast of Clearwater — was recently donated to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund by Mr. and Mrs. D. A. Salls.

The gift included approximately 6 acres of land, and the Youth Fund purchased 22 additional acres to provide for future expansion.

Youth Fund Executive Director Harry Weaver said only minor modifications will be necessary to convert the five-bath residence into a child care facility for ten youngsters plus cottage parents.

Two additional cottages, each with a capacity of ten, will be constructed in the future to bring the eventual enrollment to 30. Weaver said preference will be given to brothers and sisters. He explained there are a number of brothers and sisters living apart at the Boys Ranch and Girls Villa, separated by almost 200 miles, and the need for bringing them together

under one roof in a family-type environment has been apparent for many years.

The Florida Sheriffs Association got into the business of helping dependent, neglected and homeless youngsters in 1957 when it established the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch, near Live Oak.

Thirteen years later, the Sheriffs Association took over a project that had been started by the Sunshine State Women's Chamber of Commerce, and chartered the Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa, near Bartow.

In six years, the Villa has evolved from an idea on paper and a small bank account to a successful and still-growing institution with an enrollment of 24 girls.

Mr. and Mrs. Salls were involved in the development of the Ranch and Villa, and gave numerous gifts to the two institutions, including a herd of 53 purebred Charolais cattle that went to the Boys Ranch in 1975.

Less than a year later, the couple deeded their home and 5.61 acres of land to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, reserving a life estate. The appraised value of the gift was \$200,000.

The Salls have agreed to vacate their home before the end of 1978, after which work is expected to begin on converting it to a child care facility.

The Youth Ranch, like the Boys Ranch and Girls Villa, will

be supported entirely by voluntary contributions as a haven for dependent, neglected and homeless (but not delinquent) youngsters.

The Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, which holds title to the property, is a charitable corporation established to receive charitable gifts and distribute them to all three institutions according to the greatest need.



The 1976 Alumni Reunion at the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch was a sentimental journey for a large group of former Ranchers and special guests.

It got off to an emotional start on May 13 when Jerry Stacy, former Rancher now pursuing a musical career in Roanoke, Virginia, presented a piano concert in the Ranch chapel and dedicated it to his former cottage parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Schmutz, who are still working at the Ranch in administrative positions.

It was highlighted by a banquet at which former Baker County Sheriff Ed Yarbrough received the annual "Our Friend" award from the Boys Ranch Alumni Association; and Keynote Speaker Jack Madigan, attorney for the Florida Sheriffs Association, compared the present success of the Ranch with its early struggles.

Yarbrough, who owns a farm and a security firm, was formerly Chairman of the Boys Ranch Board of Trustees and guided the Ranch through critical years.

Madigan, whose role as legal counsel for the Sheriffs Association covers almost 25 years, has been involved in shaping the destiny of the Ranch from its very beginning.

In between the concert and banquet, there was much hand shaking and back slapping; bull sessions that lasted far into the night; a business session which included an election of new members to the board of directors; and, finally, a special Sunday morning service in the Ranch chapel and a farewell lunch in the Ranch cafeteria.

By any yardstick, it was a successful weekend. For Ranch officials who watched from the sidelines, it also served as a reminder that the Ranch is producing young men capable of becoming successful citizens, husbands and fathers.


FLORIDA SHERIFFS YOUTH FUND IS...

FROM A BEAUTIFUL a beautiful gift

BARTOW — Girls and staff members, Sheriffs and guests gathered at the Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa on May 2, to dedicate a new residence facility "to the glory of God" and in memory of the late Esther Mowry, who was described by speakers as "a beautiful person and a great friend."

In dedicatory remarks, Sheriff Jennings Murree, Chairman of the Villa Executive Committee, pointed out that, although the late Mrs. Mowry had given the new residence building to the Villa, she had modestly resisted all efforts to name it in her honor.

Instead, he said, she insisted on naming it "Dorista Villa" in honor of a South American woman who dedicated her life to caring for needy and deserving girls.

"Esther," he said, "you have been a source of inspiration to all of us, and you will continue to be in days to come. You never wanted any credit for the good things you did, and we apologize for praising you, but we could not in good conscience conduct these ceremonies in any other way.

"Although you would not permit us to use your name on

this building, as a remembrance of you, we know that your spirit of warmth and compassion will pervade Dorista Villa and have a positive influence on all of us as we continue our efforts to help dependent, neglected and homeless children.

"In the few short years that we were privileged to know you, you touched the hearts and lives of many of us in a way that will never be forgotten."

Sheriff Murrhee described the dedication ceremony as a milestone because it had increased the capacity of the Villa to 24 girls and "we have now passed the halfway mark toward our goal of 40 girls."

Mrs. Mowry, who died in June, 1975, was one of the founders of the Villa and was actively involved in its progress.

Sheriff Murrhee pointed out that she had given generous support to the Boys Ranch, as well as the Villa, and "even her estate planning reflected this equal concern for both boys and girls."

"She was always alert to ways that she could help, such as giving a much-needed camera, some patio furniture, a tele-

vision set — things that can mean so much when they are needed in the day-to-day functional operation of a child care facility."

An outdoor setting was prepared for the dedication rites, but a last-minute rain storm forced them to be held indoors.

Indian River County Sheriff Sam Joyce, Chairman of the Villa Trustees, was the master of ceremonies. Polk County Sheriff Monroe Brannen, who was primarily responsible for bringing the Villa to the Bartow area, welcomed the dedication audience.

Charlotte County Sheriff Jack Bent, President of the Florida Sheriffs Association, expressed the appreciation of his fellow Sheriffs for the generosity and deep concern Esther Mowry lavished upon the Villa.

Harry Weaver, Executive Director of the Villa, introduced special guests; and Mrs. Doris Hough, a Villa Trustee, a Villa founder and a close friend of Esther Mowry, responded to Sheriff Murrhee's dedicatory remarks.

Boys Ranch Anniversary celebration

The Boys Ranch will celebrate its 19th Anniversary on October 2 and 3, and the public is invited. There will be the usual horse show, Suwannee River barbecue, and "open house" tours of the Ranch facilities. A special highlight this year will be dedication rites for the Ed Van Ness Farm Area and the Henry Beck Education Center. (See photos above.)

The Annual Girls Villa Classic

This is a week-long celebration, at Bartow, to raise funds for, and draw attention to, the Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa. It will open August 28 with the Annual Miss Bartow Scholarship Pageant, which last year was won by a Villa resident, Laura Morrison. Other events include golf and tennis tournaments; a joint luncheon for all civic clubs, September 1; a reception and charity show featuring night club performer Duane Dee, September 3; and the Annual Girls Villa Ball, with the music by Ray Stevens, September 4.

After three tries in three years, canoeists from the Boys Ranch finally achieved their goal of completing a 160-mile "survival" trip down the Suwannee River to the Gulf of Mexico.

Twelve boys, led by Coach Earl Hurst and cottage father Virgil "Pop" Petty, launched seven canoes at the Boys Ranch at 8:35 a.m., on July 22, and arrived at a campsite near the town of Suwannee, on the Gulf, at midnight, July 24.

To accomplish this, they had to travel night and day, lashing the canoes together at night and sleeping in shifts. They also had to forage for food whenever and wherever possible, since the rules decreed that no food could be taken along, and each canoeist was limited to one blanket, a container of water, a sheath knife, a length of fishing line and a fishing hook.

When dawn broke after the end of the trip, the canoeists converged on a nearby restaurant and ate breakfasts that would have made a lumberjack envious.

The first canoe expedition in 1974 covered only about half of the distance to the Gulf because too much time was spent scrounging for food and camping overnight.

The second expedition in 1975 profited from the mistakes of the first.

There was less foraging for food, and, instead of camping, the boys lashed the canoes together and slept in shifts so they could travel night and day, but a storm aborted the trip when the Gulf was still about 50 miles away.

Coach Hurst was especially pleased that the 1976 crew finally achieved success because this was his last survival trip on
